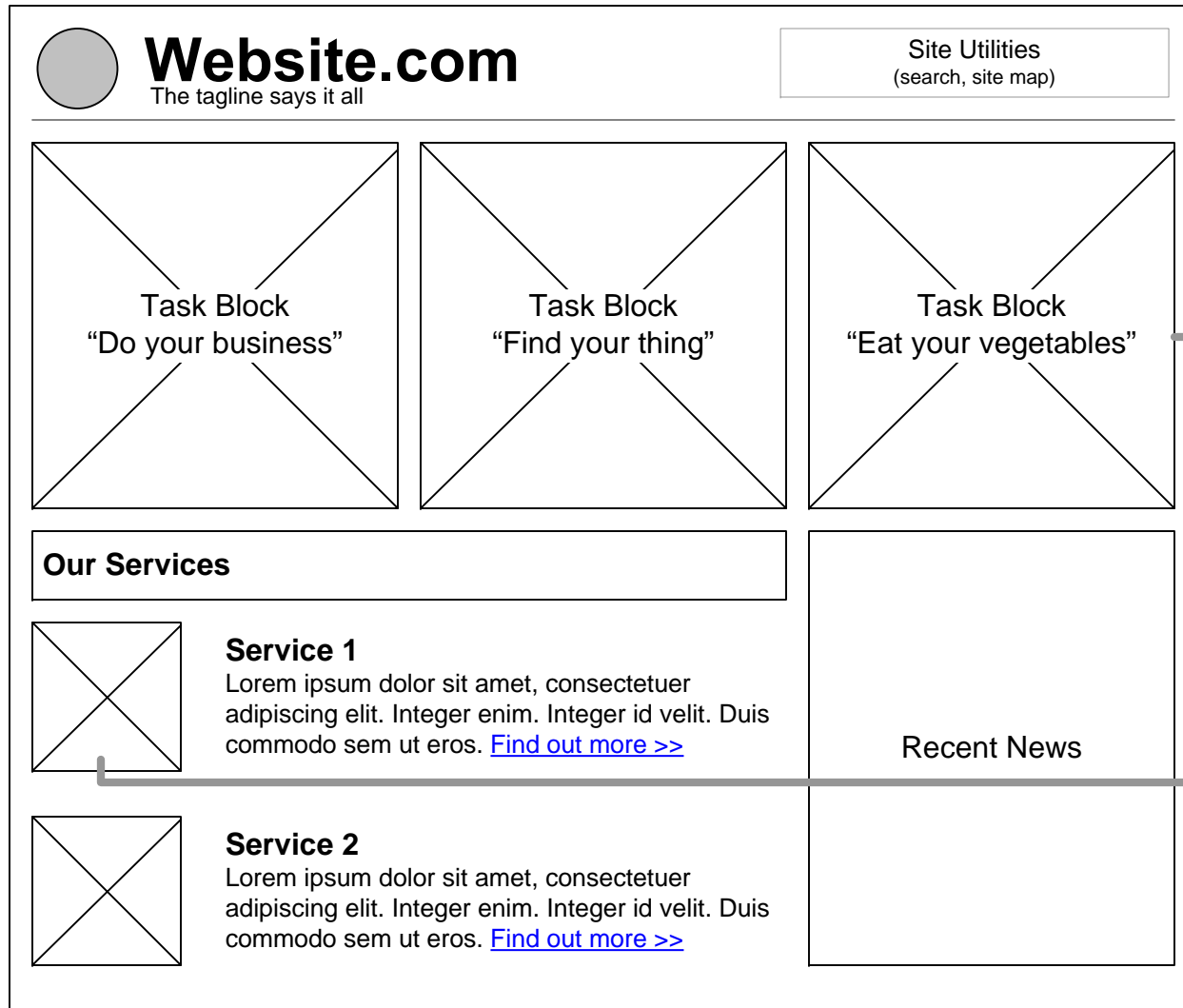

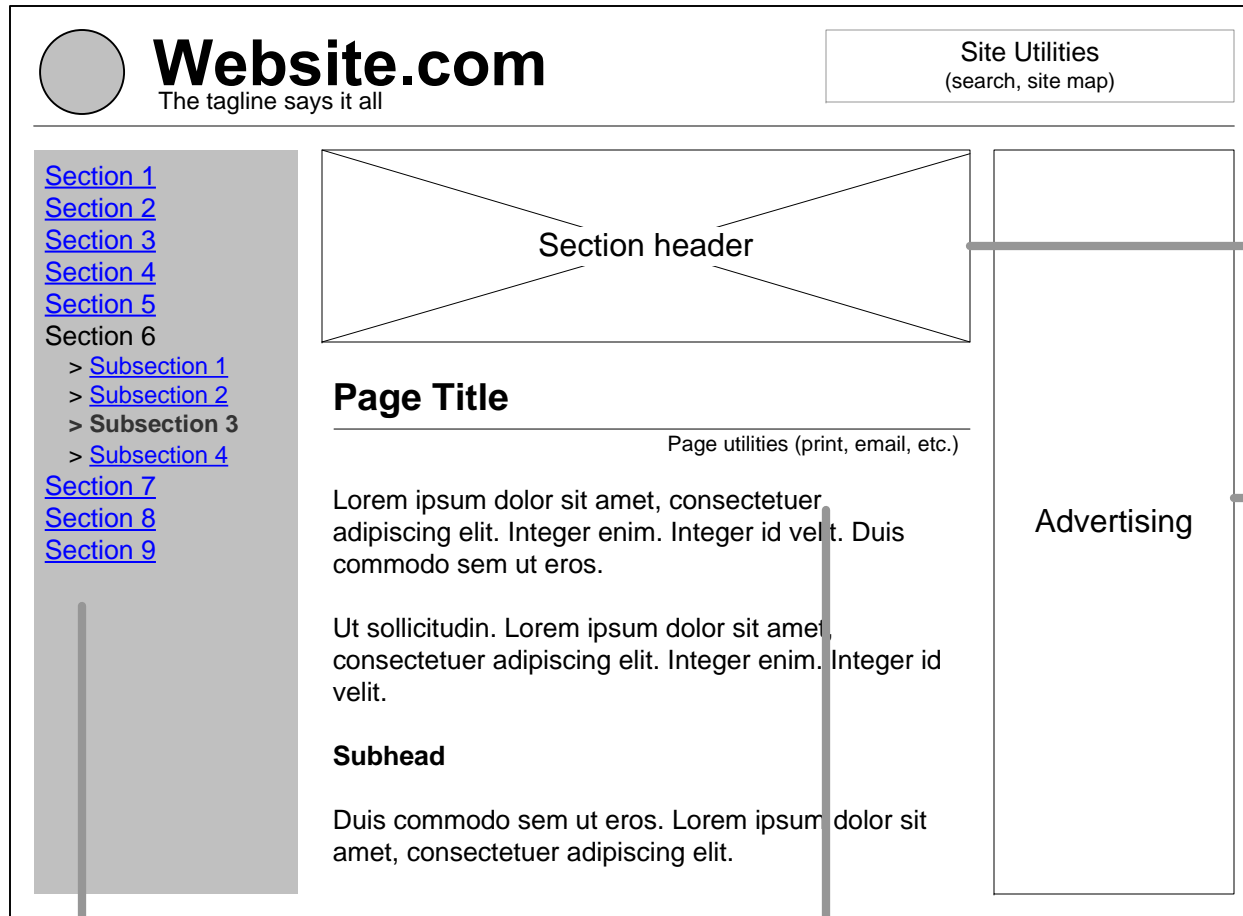


Annotations appear here on the right.

Annotations are on their own layer so they can be turned off. Just **Right click** → **View** → **Layer Properties**, deselect the “visible” field for the Annotations layer and then apply changes.

Active section is highlighted and inactive

Annotations can run on the bottom too.

Template Details

Document Title. Change this under **File** → **Properties**.

Page name. Change this under **File** → **Page Setup** → **Page Properties**, or right on the little tab at the bottom of the screen.

A few words about background pages

This template uses background pages to organize common elements, and reduce the number of changes required for elements that appear on more than one screen.

- Background-Main has the basic header and footer.
- Background-Screen 1 has an outline of the screen along with the site logo, tagline, and utility navigation.
- Background-Screen 2 has everything in Background-Screen 1, plus global navigation.

The number of backgrounds you'll need depends on the number of wireframes you have and the complexity of your navigation.

Background pages can be changed under **File** → **Page Setup** → **Page Properties**. As you've probably guessed, background pages can have their own background pages. Recursion is your friend—using multiple background pages will make building complex wireframes easier.
